THE GREATEST REVEAL OF ALL

This Is No Illusion

Every trick has an explanation. This truth has none — because it's real. Open and see.

1 All of us have sinned

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God”

Romans 3:23

Good people, kind people, religious people — **all** people. God’s standard is His own perfect glory, and every one of us falls short. The road begins with honesty, not pretending.

2 Sin pays a wage — death

“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Romans 6:23

A wage is what you earn, and sin earns separation from God — now and forever. But the verse doesn’t stop there: in the same breath, God offers a **gift**. A wage is earned; a gift is simply received.

3 But God loved you first

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

Romans 5:8

God did not wait for you to clean yourself up. While we were still sinners, Jesus Christ took our place on the cross, bore our sin, was buried, and rose again the third day.

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

John 3:16

“Whosoever” is the biggest word in the Bible — it means **you**.

4 By grace alone, through faith alone

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast.”

Ephesians 2:8–9

Salvation cannot be earned — not by baptism, church, or good deeds. It is God’s grace received through faith in Jesus Christ alone. If you could earn it, it wouldn’t be a gift.

5 Whosoever shall call

“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

Romans 10:13

Settle it today

“Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner and cannot save myself. I believe You died on the cross for my sins and rose from the grave. Right now I trust You alone as my Savior. Thank You for the free gift of eternal life. Amen.”

The words don’t save you — trusting Christ does. God looks at the heart.
